Despite the increase in doorstep collections, Britain still lags way behind most other European nations on recycling.

In addition to paper, metal and plastic products, many councils offer facilities for recycling textiles, motor oil, household and car batteries, and various other products. Some councils collect such items from the doorstep, though more commonly you'll have to go to a municipal recycling point.

Many local councils offer from-the-door recycling collection and this service should be available to everyone in the UK by the end of this year. Most doorstep schemes accept paper, cardboard, glass, and aluminium and steel cans. Some also accept plastic bottles though not, in most cases, plastic films, wrappers and trays.

When recycling at home, you are asked to always remove lids and give items a rinse in the sink before putting them in the box. To save energy, use cold rather than hot water for this.
